

SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

Attached please find the 2010 Summer School Schedule for the Pacific Union College Education Department. Please keep the following points in mind when planning your summer schedule:

1. **VERY IMPORTANT**: Let us know which EDUC classes you will take, as courses may be cancelled if nobody has signed up. Please do not count on showing up for a class that you have not signed up for and expect it to take place. This happens several times every summer, and we would not want you to be disappointed. As many of the classes have enrollment limits it is best to sign up early.
2. Due to the intensive nature of these courses and seminars it is recommended you register for only one course at a time. However, it is not mandatory. You may not sign up for courses that overlap in time.
3. **Please sign up directly with Debra Murphy** rather than through the Records Office for all Education (EDUC and HLED) classes. You will have an opportunity to formally register on the first day of class. All other classes, such as RELT, ENGL and RELH classes, can be signed up for through the Records Office.
4. Be sure you have authorization from your Conference office if they are paying for your class.
5. Let us know immediately if you have to cancel a class for which you are signed up.
6. EDUC 238, EDUC 538 and EDUC 420: Legos Workshop each require a \$25 fee. This fee is not covered by the Conference. Your place in class will be confirmed upon receipt of the fee.
